

# *Catch Brain Strain on Sky*

A QUEENSLAN bred daughter of Just The Best-Victory Moss has been donated to Sky Channel's "The Catching Pen" show and will be given away in a national competition.

The Catching Pen presenter Mark Duclos was in Queensland recently to finalise the details of the competition and to inspect the eight month old black bitch.

Tony and Jane Apap of The A Team Stud at Gatton have donated the pup, will rear it to breaking in stage and her pre-training will be handled by Paul Felgate.

Duclos said two series of the competition would be run with a weekly contestant answering greyhound trivia.

"Every week viewers will phone in on a 1900 number and register for the competition," Duclos told The Journal.

"The first series will run until July 3 and we will select the top three to go into a grand final of series one.

"The second series will start soon after, going to a top three and a grand final."

After that the winner of the first series will meet the second series winner in a trivia quiz and on the December 18 Catching Pen show, the grand winner will take home the bitch.

Duclos said the bitch's kennelname is "Sky" but The Catching Pen has already reserved the racing name "Brain Strain".

"That's going to be the name of our competition ... Brain Strain," he said.

"The bitch's future will be up to the new owner after the December 18 show.

"Sky will continually monitor the progress of the bitch in her rearing, breaking in and early education."
