THE quality of the Another Fool damline was never more evident than when Frisky Fool (Just The Best-Funky Fool) landed the Capalaba Futurity for breeder, owner and trainer Helen Lambertson.

Take Frisky Fool's dam Funky Fool for instance.

By Roanoke-Flaming Fool, Funky Fool hardly set the world on fire when she raced.

She won a maiden at Toowoomba and 11 races at lowly Moree. In fact, she was placed just once at Lismore and Albion Park from 12 starts at four other tracks.

And yet she has obviously benefited from the prepotent damline from which she comes and Frisky Fool is also the result of the proven Credibility-Flaming Fool cross.

For Lambertson it was yet another success at Capalaba, where she and partner Reg Kay have dominated for so many years. It was hardly unexpected that Lambertson would produce the Futurity winner. She had three finalists, including runner-up Jazzy Fool, and Fool's Intent.

On the other hand, Capalaba Derby winner Railroad Ghost (Awesome McLaren- Pugsley Adams) comes from yet another damline to be proud of. But Pugsley Adams was a smart racebitch winning six at Albion Park and eight in all, and she is a daughter of champion producer Brindle Cheli who is a member of the Bay Road Queen damline.

While Railroad Ghost continues to go from strength to strength, owner Sharon Morris admits it wasn't always that way.

"When we first put them into training they didn't show much and couldn't break 26 seconds for 431m at Ipswich," she said.

"But we shifted them to the bigger track at the Gold Coast and he and his brother

Railroad Thunder (also a Derby finalist) really started to improve." Railroad Ghost upset odds on favourite Ascot One from the Tom Tzouvelis kennel in the Derby.
